The cats can certainly hold their own on an agility course! The cats literally fly through the obstacles on an agility course, all while chasing a dangling feather or toy.

Come and watch Sugar and Ziva run through their paces. You can even take a turn yourself to see if you can coax either one of them to complete the course for you.
